Applications are invited for one (single) post mentioned below, under the extramural project “**SOCIO-CULTURAL DETERMINANTS, COMMUNITY AWARENESS, TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION OF PATIENTS OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER (SUD) IN ASSAM AND ARUNACHAL PRADESH**” implemented by Department of Sociology, Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh, Assam under ICMR- New Delhi.

- **Name of the Position:** Project Technical Support-III: 01 (One post)
- **Place of Work:** 6 districts of Assam (Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Cachar, Kamrup (Metro), Nagaon, Karimganj) and 2 districts of Arunachal Pradesh (Namsai, Changlang)
- **Essential qualification and experience:** Graduate Degree in Social Sciences with 2 (two) years work experience or a Post-Graduation in Social Sciences. Candidates with working knowledge of computers and familiarity with different sites of Cachar and Karimganj districts along with fluency in Bengali language would be given preference.
- **Monthly Consolidated Emoluments:** Rs. 28,000/- per month + 9% HRA = Rs. 30,520 per month.
- **Upper age –limit for fresh recruits:** 30 years
